All of you have been busy taking advantage of the 3D printing services offered by the library! Our February newsletter includes pictures of just a few of the objects that have been printed using our 3D printer.

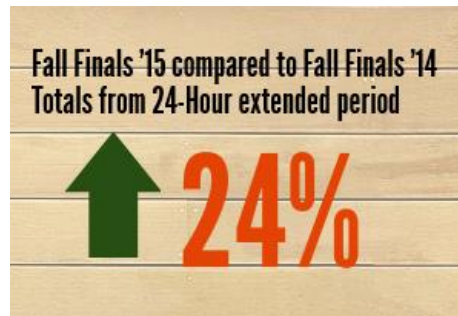

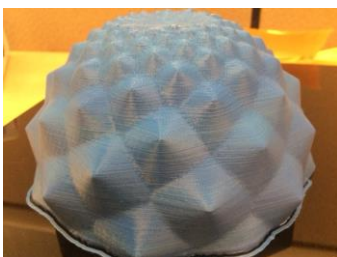

For months, University Archives and Special Collections has been busy. The University Archivist and many interns have modernized the archives to better serve students and faculty at ULV.

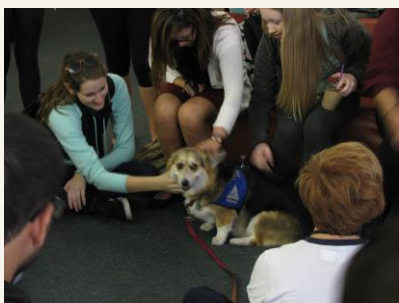
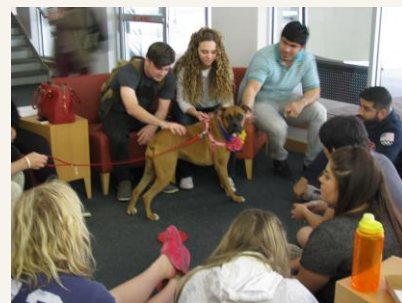
Every Thursday, we find an archival image to post online. These "Throwback Thursdays" have featured old athletic teams from La
